



Technology Approach

1/2 graders will have a 1:1 iPad device that is kept in the classroom.

- Applications they will use in class include but are not limited to *Epic*, *Reading A-Z*, *Beast Academy*, and *Sketches*.

Students might use iPads in the classroom for:

- Reading level assigned text
- Teacher Guided Research
- Math practice



Essential Skills

Transitioning to 1st grade, students will benefit from experience navigating an iPad.

- Turn on iPad and log in
- Turn VoiceOver on/off
- Gestures/keyboard/braille display commands
- Select icons, urls, radio buttons, check boxes; use scroll bar
- Swipe/double tap, drag/split tap
- Swipe up/down (scroll bar)
- Two finger swipe down, swipe up, single tap, rotor

Students will also learn to take care of their device (i.e. technology agreement expectations and class expectation of plugging in at the end of the school day to charge)



How We Prepare Students

Understand the basics of internet safety (i.e safe and school-approved apps/websites, not sharing information, telling a teacher if something makes them uncomfortable, etc.)

At the end of the year, students will be able to expertly navigate the applications on their iPad devices.

They will be able to type phrases and short sentences

Moving forward, 3rd grade students will check-out a 1:1 MacBook. Students will benefit from:

- familiarity with using a computer
- typing experience and navigating google applications.
